

Sunday School Information

Pre-school (3 year-olds) through 5th grade meet at 10:15 AM.

Children then join the congregation at the exchange of the Peace.

*Children attend the full worship service with their families on the **First Sunday** of each month.* All other Sundays children begin the worship service with the Sunday school program.

High School Students meet at 9:00 AM **every** Sunday downstairs in the EYC room. (9th grade - 12th grade)

Middle School Students meet at 9:00 AM **every** Sunday downstairs in the middle school classroom. (6th grade - 8th grade)

Peer friendships and relationships with other faithful adults will help sustain the spiritual life of the individual beyond childhood.
